the House, that they may feel humiliated because of their errors, and they must measure the pattern.

[4] - References:

- And a reed like a rod was given me as he said; Get up and measure the temple sanctuary of God and the altar and those worshiping in it. (Revelation 11:1)
- But as for the courtyard that is outside the temple sanctuary, cast it clear out and do not measure it, because it has been given to the nations, and they will trample the holy city underfoot for forty-two months. (Revelation 11:2)
- And I will cause my two witnesses to prophesy a thousand two hundred and sixty days dressed in sackcloth. (Revelation 11:3)
- These are symbolized by the two olive trees and the two lampstands and are standing before the Lord of the earth. (Revelation 11:4)
- And the man began to speak to me; Son of man, see with your eyes, and with your ears hear, and set your heart upon all that I am showing you, because for the purpose of my showing you, you have been brought here. Tell everything that you are seeing to the house of Israel. (Ezekiel 40:4)
- In order that you may remember and actually be ashamed and you may no more come to have any reason to open your mouth because of your humiliation, when I make an atonement for you for all that you have done, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 16:63)
- What, then, was the fruit that YOU used to have at that time?
  Things of which YOU are now ashamed. For the end of those things is death. (Romans 6:21)
