Ezekiel 43:13... And these are the measurements of the altar in cubits, a cubit being a cubit and a handbreadth. And its bottom is a cubit. And a cubit is the width. And its border is upon its lip round about, one span. And this is the base of the altar.

- Consequently I entreat You by the compassions of God, brothers, to present Your bodies a sacrifice living, holy, acceptable to God, a sacred service with Your power of reason. (Romans 12:1)
