- **Consequently I entreat **YOU** by the compassions of God, brothers, to present **YOUR** bodies a sacrifice living, holy, acceptable to God, a sacred service with **YOUR** power of reason. (**Romans 12:1**)**
- **And quit **being** fashioned after this system of things, but be transformed by making **YOUR** mind over, that **YOU** may prove to yourselves the good and acceptable and perfect will of God. (**Romans 12:2**)**
- **And you must make the **altar** of acacia wood, five **cubits** its length and five **cubits** its **width**. The **altar** should be foursquare, and its height three **cubits**. (**Exodus 27:1**)**
- **Then he made the copper **altar**, twenty **cubits being** its length, and twenty **cubits** its **width**, and ten **cubits** its height. (**2 Chronicles 4:1**)**
- **And, look! There was a wall outside the house all **round about**. And in the hand of the man there was the measuring reed of six **cubits**, by a **cubit** and a **handbreadth**. And he began to measure the breadth of the thing built, one reed, and the height, one reed. (**Ezekiel 40:5**)**
