- **And I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the former heaven and the former earth had passed away, and the sea is no more. (Revelation 21:1)**
- **I saw also the **holy** city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God and prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. (Revelation 21:2)**

- In that time they **will** call Jerusalem the **throne** of Yehowah, and to her all the nations must be brought together to the **name** of Yehowah at Jerusalem, and they **will** no more walk after the stubbornness of their bad heart. (**Jeremiah 3:17**)
- And above the expanse that was over their head there was something in appearance like sapphire stone, the likeness of a **throne**. And upon the likeness of the **throne** there was a likeness of someone in appearance like an earthling man upon it, up above. (**Ezekiel 1:26**)
- Then David the king rose to his **feet** and said; Hear me, my brothers and my people. As for me, it was close to my heart to build a resting **house** for the ark of the covenant of Yehowah and as the footstool of our God, and I had made preparation to build. (**1 Chronicles 28:2**)
- Exalt Yehowah our God and bow down yourselves at his footstool, he is **holy**. (**Psalms 99:5**)
- And I **will** tabernacle in the **midst** of the **sons** of **Israel**, and I **will** prove to be their God. (**Exodus 29:45**)
- Why do **you**, O **you** mountains of peaks, keep watching enviously the mountain that God has desired for himself to dwell in? Even Yehowah himself **will reside** there forever. (**Psalms 68:16**)
- This is my resting-place forever, here I shall dwell, for I have longed for it. (**Psalms 132:14**)
- And **you** people **will** have to know that I am Yehowah **YOUR** God, residing in Zion my **holy** mountain. And Jerusalem must become a **holy place**, and as regards strangers, they **will** no more pass through her. (**Joel 3:17**)
- And what agreement does God's temple have with idols? For we are a temple of a living God, just as God said; I shall **reside** among them and walk among them, and I shall be their God, and they **will** be my people. (**2 Corinthians 6:16**)
- And my **holy name** I shall make known in the **midst** of my people **Israel**, and I shall no more let my **holy name** be profaned, and the nations **will** have to know that I am Yehowah, the Holy One in Israel. (**Ezekiel 39:7**)

- And it must occur in that day, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, that I shall cut off the **names** of the idols out of the land, and they **will** no more be remembered, and also the prophets and the spirit of uncleanness I shall cause to pass out of the land. (**Zechariah 13:2**)
- It was then that Solomon proceeded to build a high **place** to Chemosh the disgusting thing of Moab on the mountain that was in front of Jerusalem, and to Molech the disgusting thing of the **sons** of Ammon. (**1 Kings 11:7**)
