

Ezekiel 44:15 And as for the Levitical priests, the sons of Zadok, who took care of the obligation of my sanctuary when the sons of Israel wandered away from me, they themselves will come near to me to minister to me, and they must stand before me to present to me fat and the blood, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah.

- And the dining room the front of which is toward the north is for the **priests** who are taking **care** of the **obligation** of the altar. They are the **sons** of **Zadok**, who, from the **sons** of Levi, are approaching Yehowah to **minister** to him. (**Ezekiel 40:46**)
- And you **must** give to the Levitical **priests**, who are of the offspring of **Zadok**, the ones approaching me, is the **utterance** of the **Sovereign Lord** Yehowah, to **minister** to me, a young bull, the son of the herd, as a sin offering. (**Ezekiel 43:19**)
- Upon that the king put Benaiah the son of Jehoiada in place of him over the army, and **Zadok** the priest the king put in the place of Abiathar. (**1 Kings 2:35**)
- But as for the Levites who got far **away** from me when **Israel**, who **wandered away** from me, **wandered** after their dungy idols, they **must** also bear their error. (**Ezekiel 44:10**)
- It **will** be for the **priests**, those who are sanctified from the **sons** of **Zadok**, who **took care** of the **obligation** toward me, who did not wander **away** when the **sons** of **Israel** **wandered away**, just as the Levites **wandered away**. (**Ezekiel 48:11**)
- At that particular time Yehowah separated the tribe of Levi to carry the ark of Yehowah's covenant, to **stand before** Yehowah for ministering to him and to bless in his name until this day. (**Deuteronomy 10:8**)
- And you **must** give to the Levitical **priests**, who are of the offspring of **Zadok**, the ones approaching me, is the **utterance** of the **Sovereign Lord** Yehowah, to **minister** to me, a young bull, the son of the herd, as a sin offering. (**Ezekiel 43:19**)
- And the priest **must** make them smoke upon the altar as food, an offering made by fire for a restful odor. All the **fat** belongs to Yehowah. (**Leviticus 3:16**)

- And the priest **must** sprinkle the blood upon Yehowah's altar at the entrance of the tent of meeting, and he **must** make the **fat** smoke as a restful odor to Yehowah. (**Leviticus 17:6**)
- And he **must present** some of the communion sacrifice as an offering made by fire to Yehowah, namely, the **fat** that covers the intestines, even all the **fat** that is over the intestines. (**Leviticus 3:3**)
- As for **Zadok** the priest and Benaiah the son of Jehoiada and Nathan the prophet and Shimei and Rei and the mighty men that belonged to David, they did not become involved with Adonijah. (**1 Kings 1:8**)
- And these are the princes that he had; Azariah the son of **Zadok**, the priest. (**1 Kings 4:2**)
- Saying to the **priests** who belonged to the house of Yehowah of armies, and to the prophets, even saying; Shall I weep in the fifth month, practicing an abstinence, the way I have done these O how many years? (**Zechariah 7:3**)
- And **you will** have to know that I have sent to **you** this commandment, in order that my covenant with Levi may continue, Yehowah of armies has said. (**Malachi 2:4**)
