Ezekiel 44:19... And when they go forth to the outer courtyard, even to the outer courtyard to the people, they should strip off their garments in which they were ministering, and they must deposit them in the holy dining rooms and put on other garments, that they may not sanctify the people with their garments.

- But a physical man does not receive the things of the spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot get to know them, because they are examined spiritually. (1 Corinthians 2:14)
- However, the spiritual man examines indeed all things, but he himself is not examined by any man. (1 Corinthians 2:15)
- And the priest must clothe himself with his official dress of linen, and he will put the linen drawers on over his flesh. Then he must lift up the fatty ashes of the burnt offering that the fire regularly consumes upon the altar, and he must place them beside the altar. (Leviticus 6:10)
- And he proceeded to say to me; The dining rooms of the north and the dining rooms of the south that are before the separated area, they are the holy dining rooms, where the priests who are approaching Yehowah eat the most holy things. There they deposit the most holy things and the grain offering and the sin offering and the guilt offering, because the place is holy. (Ezekiel 42:13)
- When they, the priests, have come in, they will not also go out from the holy place to the outer courtyard, but there they will deposit their garments in which they customarily minister, for they are something holy. They will clothe themselves with other garments, and must approach to what has to do with the people. (Ezekiel 42:14)
- And you must sanctify them that they may indeed become most holy. Anyone touching them is to be holy. (Exodus 30:29)
- Everything that may touch its flesh will become holy, and when anyone spatters some of its blood upon the garment, you will wash what he spatters blood upon in a holy place. (Leviticus 6:27)

- And Aaron must come into the tent of meeting and strip off the linen garments that he put on when he went into the holy place, and he must lay them down there. (Leviticus 16:23)
- When they, the priests, have come in, they will not also go out from the holy place to the outer courtyard, but there they will deposit their garments in which they customarily minister, for they are something holy.
