Ezekiel 44:31... No body already dead and no creature torn to pieces of the flying creatures or of the beasts should the priests eat.

- And you should prove yourselves holy men to me, and you must not eat flesh in the field that is something torn by a wild beast. You should throw it to the dogs. (Exodus 22:31)
- He should also not eat any body already dead or anything torn by wild beasts so as to become unclean by it. I am Yehowah. (Leviticus 22:8)
- You must not eat any body already dead. To the alien resident who is inside your gates you may give it, and he must eat it, or there may be a selling of it to a foreigner, because you are a holy people to Yehowah your God. You must not boil a kid in its mother's milk. (Deuteronomy 14:21)
- But to write them to abstain from things polluted by idols and from fornication and from what is strangled and from blood. (Acts of Apostles 15:20)
- A son, for his part, honors a father, and a servant, his grand master. So if I am a father, where is the honor to me? And if I am a grand master, where is the fear of me? Yehowah of armies has said to you, O priests who are despising my name. And you have said; In what way have we despised your name? (Malachi 1:6)
- By presenting upon my altar polluted bread. And you have said; In what way have we polluted you? By your saying; The table of Yehowah is something to be despised. (Malachi 1:7)
- And when you present a blind animal for sacrificing; It is nothing bad. And when you present a lame animal or a sick one; It is nothing bad. Bring it near, please, to your governor. Will he find pleasure in you, or will he receive you kindly? Yehowah of armies has said. (Malachi 1:8)
- And he who eats any of its dead body will wash his garments, and he must be unclean until the evening, and he who carries off its dead body will wash his garments, and he must be unclean until the evening. (Leviticus 11:40)
