

**Ezekiel 44:31** **No body already dead and no creature torn to pieces of the flying creatures or of the beasts should the priests eat.**

[6] - References:

- And **you** should prove yourselves holy men to me, and **you** must not **eat** flesh in the field that is something **torn** by a wild beast. **You** should throw it to the dogs. (**Exodus 22:31**)
- He should also not **eat** any body already **dead** or anything **torn** by wild **beasts** so as to become unclean by it. I am Yehowah. (**Leviticus 22:8**)
- **You** must not **eat** any body already **dead**. To the alien resident who is inside your gates you may give it, and he must **eat** it, or there may be a selling of it to a foreigner, because you are a holy people to Yehowah your God. You must not boil a kid in its mother's milk. (**Deuteronomy 14:21**)
- But to write them to abstain from things polluted by idols and from fornication and from what is strangled and from blood. (**Acts of Apostles 15:20**)
- A son, for his part, honors a father, and a servant, his grand master. So if I am a father, where is the honor to me? And if I am a grand master, where is the fear of me? Yehowah of armies has said to **you**, O **priests** who are despising my name. And **you** have said; In what way have we despised your name? (**Malachi 1:6**)
- By presenting upon my altar polluted bread. And **you** have said; In what way have we polluted you? By **your** saying; The table of Yehowah is something to be despised. (**Malachi 1:7**)
- And when **you** present a blind animal for sacrificing; It is nothing bad. And when **you** present a lame animal or a sick one; It is nothing bad. Bring it near, please, to your governor. Will he find pleasure in you, or will he receive you kindly? Yehowah of armies has said. (**Malachi 1:8**)
- And he who **eats** any of its **dead** body will wash his garments, and he must be unclean until the evening, and he who carries off its **dead** body will wash his garments, and he must be unclean until the evening. (**Leviticus 11:40**)
