**And when you people allot the land as an inheritance, you should offer a contribution to Yehowah, a holy portion out of the land, as to length, twenty-five thousand cubits in length, and as to width, ten<sup>1</sup> thousand. It will be a holy portion in all its<sup>2</sup> boundaries round about.**

- Their **inheritance** was by lot, just as Yehowah had commanded by means of Moses for the nine tribes and the half tribe. (**Joshua 14:2**)
- And it must occur that **you** should **allot** it for **inheritance** to yourselves and to the alien residents who are residing as aliens in **YOUR** midst, who have become father to sons in the midst of **YOU**. And they must become to **you** like a native among the sons of Israel. With **you people** they **will** fall by lot into an **inheritance** in the midst of the tribes of Israel. (**Ezekiel 47:22**)
- Honor Yehowah with your valuable things and with the firstfruits of all your produce. (**Proverbs 3:9**)
- And on the boundary of Judah, from the eastern border to the western border, the **contribution** that **you people** should contribute should prove to be **twenty-five thousand** cubits in **width**, and the **length** according to one of the **portions** from the eastern border to the western border. And the sanctuary must prove to be in the midst of it. (**Ezekiel 48:8**)
- As regards the **contribution** that **you** should contribute to Yehowah, the **length will** be **twenty-five thousand** cubits and the **width ten thousand**. (**Ezekiel 48:9**)
- The whole **contribution** is **twenty-five thousand** cubits by **twenty-five thousand**. A foursquare part **you people** should contribute as the **holy contribution** with the possession of the city. (**Ezekiel 48:20**)
- And all the low plain of the carcasses and of the fatty ashes, and all the terraces as far as the torrent valley of Kidron, clear to the corner of the Horse Gate toward the sunrising, **will** be something

- holy** to Yehowah. It **will** not be uprooted, neither **will** it be torn down anymore to time indefinite. (**Jeremiah 31:40**)
- **And on the boundary of Judah, from the eastern border to the western border, the **contribution** that **you people** should contribute should prove to be **twenty-five thousand** cubits in **width**, and the **length** according to one of the **portions** from the eastern border to the western border. And the sanctuary must prove to be in the midst of it. (**Ezekiel 48:8**)**
  - **And what is left remaining over in **length will** be exactly as the **holy contribution**, **ten thousand** cubits to the east, and **ten thousand** to the west, and it must prove to be exactly as the **holy contribution**, and its produce must come to be for bread for the ones serving the city. (**Ezekiel 48:18**)**
