Ezekiel 45:12.. And the shekel ${ }^{1}$ is twenty gerahs. ${ }^{2}$ Twenty shekels, twenty-five shekels, fifteen shekels should prove to be the maneh for you.

- This is what all those will give who pass over to those numbered, a half shekel by the shekel of the holy place. Twenty gerahs equal a shekel. A half shekel is the contribution to Yehowah. (Exodus 30:13)
- Now every value should be estimated in the shekel of the holy place. The shekel should amount to twenty gerahs. (Leviticus 27:25)
- You must take five shekels for each individual. In the shekel of the holy place you should take it. A shekel is twenty gerahs. (Numbers 3:47)
