exekiel 45:17... And upon the chieftain will devolve the whole burnt offerings and the grain offering and the drink offering during the festivals and during the new moons and during the Sabbaths, during all the festal seasons of the house of Israel. He will be the one to provide the sin offering and the grain offering and the whole burnt offering and the communion sacrifices, in order to make atonement in behalf of the house of Israel.

- Wash yourselves, make yourselves clean, remove the badness of YOUR dealings from in front of my eyes, cease to do bad. (Isaiah 1:16)
- Learn to do good, search for justice, set right the oppressor, render judgment for the fatherless boy, plead the cause of the widow. (Isaiah 1:17)
- When David finished offering up the burnt offering and the communion sacrifices, he went on to bless the people in the name of Yehowah. (1 Chronicles 16:2)
- For Hezekiah the king of Judah himself contributed for the congregation a thousand bulls and seven thousand sheep, and the princes themselves contributed for the congregation a thousand bulls and ten thousand sheep, and priests kept sanctifying themselves in great number. (2 Chronicles 30:24)
- And it will certainly occur that from new moon to new moon and from Sabbath to Sabbath all flesh will come in to bow down before me, Yehowah has said. (Isaiah 66:23)
- And Yehowah went on speaking to Moses, saying; (Leviticus 23:1)
- Speak to the sons of Israel, and you must say to them; The seasonal festivals of Yehowah that you should proclaim are holy conventions. These are my seasonal festivals. (Leviticus 23:2)
- Six days may work be done, but on the seventh day is a Sabbath of complete rest, a holy convention. You may do no sort of work. It is a Sabbath to Yehowah in all places where you dwell. (Leviticus 23:3)

- These are the seasonal festivals of Yehowah, holy conventions, which you should proclaim at their appointed times. (Leviticus 23:4)
- And on that day, in his own behalf and in behalf of all the people of the land, the chieftain must provide a young bull as a sin offering. (Ezekiel 45:22)
- On that day the king had to sanctify the middle of the courtyard that is before the house of Yehowah, because there he had to render up the burnt sacrifice and the grain offering and the fat pieces of the communion sacrifices, for the copper altar that is before Yehowah was too small to contain the burnt sacrifice and the grain offering and the fat pieces of the communion sacrifices. (1 Kings 8:64)
- And what is needed, young bulls as well as rams and lambs for the burnt offerings to the God of heaven, wheat, salt, wine and oil, just as the priests that are in Jerusalem say, let there be given them continually day by day without fail. (Ezra 6:9)
- Josiah now contributed to the sons of the people flocks, male lambs and male kids, the whole for the Passover victims for all who were to be found, to the number of thirty thousand, and cattle, three thousand. These were from the goods of the king. (2 Chronicles 35:7)
- Even as a daily matter of course to make offerings according to the commandment of Moses for the Sabbaths and for the new moons and for the appointed festivals three times in the year, at the festival of unfermented cakes and at the festival of the weeks and at the festival of the booths. (2 Chronicles 8:13)
- And there was a portion of the king from his own goods for the burnt offerings, for the burnt offerings of the morning and the evening, and also the burnt offerings for the Sabbaths and for the new moons and for the festival seasons, according to what is written in the Law of Yehowah. (2 Chronicles 31:3)
- Speak to the sons of Israel, and you must say to them; The seasonal festivals of Yehowah that you should proclaim are holy conventions. These are my seasonal festivals. (Leviticus 23:2)
- However, on the tenth of this seventh month is the day of atonement. A holy convention should take place for you, and you

- must afflict YOUR souls and present an offering made by fire to Yehowah. (Leviticus 23:27)
- And the whole burnt offering that the chieftain should present to Yehowah on the Sabbath day should be six sound male lambs and a sound ram. (Ezekiel 46:4)
- And in case the chieftain should provide as a voluntary offering a whole burnt offering, or communion sacrifices as a voluntary offering to Yehowah, one must also open to him the gate that is facing east, and he must provide his whole burnt offering and his communion sacrifices just as he does on the Sabbath day. And he must go out, and one must shut the gate after his going out. (Ezekiel 46:12)
