- For the four sides he measured it. It had a wall all around, with a length of **five hundred** reeds and a width of **five hundred** reeds, to make a division between what is **holy** and what is profane. (**Ezekiel 42:20**)
- And they proceeded to speak to them in Shiloh in the land of Canaan, saying; Yehowah by means of Moses commanded cities to be given us in which to dwell, together with their **pasture grounds** for our domestic animals. (**Joshua 21:2**)
- And the city must come to **have a pasture ground**, to the north two **hundred** and **fifty cubits**, and to the south two **hundred** and **fifty**, and to the east two **hundred** and **fifty**, and to the west two **hundred** and **fifty**. (**Ezekiel 48:17**)
