

Ezekiel 45:22 And on that day, in his own behalf and in behalf of all the people of the land, the chieftain must provide a young bull as a sin offering.

[5] - References:

- But if he has doubts, he is already condemned if he eats, because he does not eat out of faith. Indeed, everything that is not out of faith is sin. (**Romans 14:23**)
- But this man offered one sacrifice for sins perpetually and sat down at the right hand of God. (**Hebrews 10:12**)
- Therefore, if one knows how to do what is right and yet does not do it, it is a sin for him. (**James 4:17**)
- And the sin that they have committed against it has become known, then the congregation **must** present a **young bull** for a sin **offering** and **must** bring it before the tent of meeting. (**Leviticus 4:14**)
- And upon the **chieftain** will devolve the whole burnt **offerings** and the grain **offering** and the drink **offering** during the festivals and during the new moons and during the Sabbaths, during all the festal seasons of the house of Israel. He will be the one to **provide** the sin **offering** and the grain **offering** and the whole burnt **offering** and the communion sacrifices, in order to make atonement in **behalf** of the house of Israel. (**Ezekiel 45:17**)
