As a holy portion out of the land it will come to be for the priests themselves, the ministers of the sanctuary, those approaching to minister to Yehowah. And for them it must prove to be a place for houses, and a sacred place¹ for the sanctuary.

- For both if we live, we live to Yehowah, and if we die, we die to Yehowah. Therefore both if we live and if we die, we belong to Yehowah. (Romans 14:8)
- For Yehowah's share is his people, Jacob is the allotment that he inherits. (Deuteronomy 32:9)
- It will be for the priests, those who are sanctified from the sons of Zadok, who took care of the obligation toward me, who did not wander away when the sons of Israel wandered away, just as the Levites wandered away. (Ezekiel 48:11)
- Then he spoke to Korah and to his entire assembly, saying; In the morning Yehowah will make known who belongs to him and who is holy and who must come near to him, and whoever he may choose will come near to him. (Numbers 16:5)
- And the dining room the front of which is toward the north is for the priests who are taking care of the obligation of the altar. They are the sons of Zadok, who, from the sons of Levi, are approaching Yehowah to minister to him. (Ezekiel 40:46)
- And you must give to the Levitical priests, who are of the offspring of Zadok, the ones approaching me, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, to minister to me, a young bull, the son of the herd, as a sin offering. (Ezekiel 43:19)
- And it must become theirs as an inheritance; I am their inheritance. And no possession should you people give them in Israel. I am their possession. (Ezekiel 44:28)
- And as to these there should prove to be the holy contribution for the priests, to the north twenty-five thousand cubits, and to the west a width of ten thousand, and to the east a width of ten thousand, and to the south a length of twenty-five thousand.

And the sanctuary of Yehowah must prove to be in the midst of it. (Ezekiel 48:10)

And they must come to have a contribution from the contribution of the land as something most holy, on the boundary of the Levites. (Ezekiel 48:12)
