thousand in width. It will become the Levites', the ministers of the house. As a possession they will have twenty dining rooms.

- Finally all the land of Egypt became famished and the people began to cry to Pharaoh for bread. Then Pharaoh said to all the Egyptians; Go to Joseph. Whatever he says to You, You are to do. (Genesis 41:55)
- And as to these there should prove to be the holy contribution for the priests, to the north twenty-five thousand cubits, and to the west a width of ten thousand, and to the east a width of ten thousand, and to the south a length of twenty-five thousand. And the sanctuary of Yehowah must prove to be in the midst of it. (Ezekiel 48:10)
- And the Levites should have, right next to the territory of the priests, twenty-five thousand cubits in length, and in width ten thousand, the whole length being twenty-five thousand and width being ten thousand. (Ezekiel 48:13)
- For in office of trust there were four mighty men of the gatekeepers. They were Levites, and they proved to be in charge of the dining rooms and of the treasures of the house of the true God. (1 Chronicles 9:26)
- And he gradually brought me into the outer courtyard, and, look! There were dining rooms, and a pavement made for the courtyard all around. There were thirty dining rooms upon the pavement. (Ezekiel 40:17)
