

Ezekiel 45:5 There will be twenty-five thousand in length and ten thousand in width. It will become the Levites', the ministers of the house. As a possession they will have twenty dining rooms.

- And the Lord said; Who really is the faithful steward, the discreet one, whom his master **will** appoint over his body of attendants to keep giving them their measure of food supplies at the proper time? (**Luke 12:42**)
- Happy is that slave, if his master on arriving finds him doing so! (**Luke 12:43**)
- I tell **you** truthfully, He **will** appoint him over all his belongings. (**Luke 12:44**)
- Finally all the land of Egypt became famished and the people began to cry to Pharaoh for bread. Then Pharaoh said to all the Egyptians; Go to Joseph. Whatever he says to **you**, **you** are to do. (**Genesis 41:55**)
- And as to these there should prove to be the holy contribution for the priests, to the north **twenty-five thousand** cubits, and to the west a **width** of **ten thousand**, and to the east a **width** of **ten thousand**, and to the south a **length** of **twenty-five thousand**. And the sanctuary of Yehowah must prove to be in the midst of it. (**Ezekiel 48:10**)
- And the Levites should **have**, right next to the territory of the priests, **twenty-five thousand** cubits in **length**, and in **width** **ten thousand**, the whole **length** being **twenty-five thousand** and **width** being **ten thousand**. (**Ezekiel 48:13**)
- For in office of trust there were four mighty men of the gatekeepers. They were Levites, and they proved to be in charge of the **dining rooms** and of the treasures of the **house** of the true God. (**1 Chronicles 9:26**)
- And he gradually brought me into the outer courtyard, and, look! There were **dining rooms**, and a pavement made for the courtyard all around. There were thirty **dining rooms** upon the pavement. (**Ezekiel 40:17**)
