

Ezekiel 46:1 **“ This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, As regards the gate of the inner courtyard that is facing east, it should continue shut for the six workdays, and on the Sabbath day it should be opened, and on the day of the new moon it should be opened.**

[6] - References:

- Then Yehowah **said** to me; As **regards** this **gate**, **shut** is how it will **continue**. It will not be **opened**, and no mere man will come in by it, for Yehowah himself, the God of Israel, **has** come in by it, and it must **continue shut**. (**Ezekiel 44:2**)
- You are to render service and you must do all your work **six days**. (**Exodus 20:9**)
- On the **new moon**, **BLOW** the horn, on the full **moon**, for the **day** of our festival. (**Psalms 81:3**)
- And it will certainly occur that from **new moon** to **new moon** and from **Sabbath** to **Sabbath** all flesh will come in to bow down before me, Yehowah **has said**. (**Isaiah 66:23**)
- And he gradually brought me into the **inner courtyard** by way of the **east**, and he proceeded to measure the **gate** as of the same measurements as these. (**Ezekiel 40:32**)
- And he proceeded to bring me back by way of the **gate** of the sanctuary, the outer one **facing east**, and it was **shut**. (**Ezekiel 44:1**)
