Ezekiel 46:11... And in the festivals and in the festal seasons the grain offering should prove to be an ephah for the young bull and an ephah for the ram, and for the male lambs as he is able to give, and, as regards oil, a hin to the ephah.

- Speak to the sons of Israel, and you must say to them; The seasonal festivals of Yehowah that You should proclaim are holy conventions. These are my seasonal festivals. (Leviticus 23:2)
- Then you must celebrate the festival of weeks to Yehowah your God, according to the voluntary offering of your hand that you will give, just as Yehowah your God may bless you.

 (Deuteronomy 16:10)
- And as a grain offering an ephah for the young bull and an ephah for the ram he should provide, and, as regards oil, a hin to the ephah. (Ezekiel 45:24)
- And an ephah for the young bull and an ephah for the ram he should render up as a grain offering, and for the male lambs according to what he is able to afford, and, as regards oil, a hin to the ephah. (Ezekiel 46:7)
- And in the seventh month, on the first of the month, you should hold a holy convention. No sort of laborious work must you do. It should prove to be a day of the trumpet blast for you. (Numbers 29:1)
