And as a grain offering an ephah for the ram, and for the male lambs a grain offering as he is able to give, and, as regards oil, a hin to the ephah.

- And as a grain offering an ephah for the young bull and an ephah for the ram he should provide, and, as regards oil, a hin to the ephah. (Ezekiel 45:24)
- And an ephah for the young bull and an ephah for the ram he should render up as a grain offering, and for the male lambs according to what he is able to afford, and, as regards oil, a hin to the ephah. (Ezekiel 46:7)
- And three tenth measures of fine flour as a grain offering moistened with oil for each bull and two tenth measures of fine flour as a grain offering moistened with oil for the one ram. (Numbers 28:12)
- The gift of each one's hand should be in proportion to the blessing of Yehowah your God that he has given you. (Deuteronomy 16:17)
- However, if he is lowly and does not have enough means, he must then take one young ram as a guilt offering for a wave offering in order to make atonement for him and one tenth of an ephah of fine flour moistened with oil as a grain offering and a log measure of oil. (Leviticus 14:21)
