

Ezekiel 46:7 And an ephah for the young bull and an ephah for the ram he should render up as a grain offering, and for the male lambs according to what he is able to afford,¹ and, as regards oil, a hin to the ephah.

- Now an omer is a tenth of an ephah measure. (Exodus 16:36)
- And as a grain offering an ephah for the young bull and an ephah for the ram he should provide, and, as regards oil, a hin to the ephah. (Ezekiel 45:24)
- And as a grain offering an ephah for the ram, and for the male lambs a grain offering as he is able to give, and, as regards oil, a hin to the ephah. (Ezekiel 46:5)
- And in the festivals and in the festal seasons the grain offering should prove to be an ephah for the young bull and an ephah for the ram, and for the male lambs as he is able to give, and, as regards oil, a hin to the ephah. (Ezekiel 46:11)
