

**Ezekiel 46:8** And when the chieftain comes in, by the way of the porch of the gate he should come in, and by the way of it he should go out.

[3] - References:

- And the sixth one poured **out** his bowl upon the great river Euphrates, and its water was dried up, that the **way** might be prepared for the kings from the rising of the sun. (**Revelation 16:12**)
- As for all the people of the land, they will be responsible for this contribution to the chieftain in Israel. (**Ezekiel 45:16**)
- And on that day, in his own behalf and in behalf of all the people of the land, the chieftain must provide a young bull as a sin offering. (**Ezekiel 45:22**)
- And the chieftain must **come** in by the **way** of the **porch** of the **gate**, from outside, and stand by the doorpost of the **gate**, and the priests must render up his whole burnt offering and his communion sacrifices, and he must bow down upon the threshold of the **gate**, and he must **go out**, but the **gate** itself should not be shut until the evening. (**Ezekiel 46:2**)
