in the festal seasons, the one coming in by the way of the north gate in order to bow down should go out by the way of the south gate, and the one coming in by the way of the south go out by the way of the gate should go out by the way of the gate to the north. No one should go back by the way of the gate by which he came in, for he<sup>1</sup> should go out straight ahead of him.
