

**Ezekiel 47:1**

**And gradually he brought me back to the entrance of the House, and, look! There was water going forth from under the threshold of the House eastward, for the front of the House was east. And the water was going down from under, from the right-hand side of the House, south of the altar.**

[14] - References:

- Hey there, all **you** thirsty ones! Come to the **water**. And the ones that have no money! Come, buy and eat. Yes, come, buy wine and milk even without money and without price. (**Isaiah 55:1**)
- Because there are two bad things that my people have done; They have left even me, the source of living **water**, in order to hew out for themselves cisterns, broken cisterns, that cannot contain the **water**. (**Jeremiah 2:13**)
- Whoever drinks from the **water** that I will give him will never get thirsty at all, but the **water** that I will give him will become in him a fountain of **water** bubbling up to impart everlasting life. (**John 4:14**)
- He that puts faith in me, just as the Scripture has said; Out from his inmost part streams of living **water** will flow. (**John 7:38**)
- And he proceeded to bring me into the temple, and he went measuring the side pillars, six cubits being the width over here and six cubits the width over there, the width of the side pillar. (**Ezekiel 41:1**)
- Because the Lamb, who is in the midst of the throne, will shepherd them, and will guide them to fountains of **waters** of life. And God will wipe out every tear from their eyes. (**Revelation 7:17**)
- And I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the former heaven and the former earth had passed away, and the sea is no more. (**Revelation 21:1**)
- I saw also the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming **down** out of heaven from God and prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. (**Revelation 21:2**)

- In that day there will come to be a well opened to the house of David and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem for sin and for an abhorrent thing. (**Zechariah 13:1**)
- And it must occur in that day that living **waters** will go forth from Jerusalem, half of them to the eastern sea and half of them to the western sea. In summer and in winter it will occur. (**Zechariah 14:8**)
- And this Good News of the kingdom will be preached in all the inhabited earth for a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come. (**Matthew 24:14**)
- Because there are two bad things that my people have done; They have left even me, the source of living **water**, in order to hew out for themselves cisterns, broken cisterns, that cannot contain the **water**. (**Jeremiah 2:13**)
- And the glory of Yehowah itself came into the **House** by way of the gate the **front** of which was toward the **east**. (**Ezekiel 43:4**)
- And alongside the torrent there will come up, along its bank on this side and on that side, all sorts of trees for food. Their leafage will not wither, nor will their fruitage be consumed. In their months they will bear new fruit, because the **water** for them, it is coming forth from the very sanctuary. And their fruitage must prove to be for food and their leafage for healing. (**Ezekiel 47:12**)
- And it must occur in that day that the mountains will drip with sweet wine, and the very hills will flow with milk, and the very streambeds of Judah will all flow with **water**. And out of the house of Yehowah there will go forth a spring, and it must irrigate the torrent valley of the Acacia Trees. (**Joel 3:18**)
