Ezekiel 47:17... And the boundary from the sea must prove to be Hazarenon, the boundary of Damascus and north, northward, and the boundary of Hamath. This is the northern side.

- And the boundary must go out to Ziphron, and its termination must prove to be Hazar-enan. This will become YOUR north boundary. (Numbers 34:9)
