Damascus and between Gilead and the land of Israel, the Jordan, from the boundary to the eastern sea you people should measure. This is the eastern side.

- And I saw in the right hand of the One seated upon the throne a scroll written within and on the reverse side, sealed tight with seven seals. (Revelation 5:1)
- And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice; Who is worthy to open the scroll and loose its seals? (Revelation 5:2)
- But neither in heaven nor upon earth nor underneath the earth was there a single one able to open the scroll or to look into it. (Revelation 5:3)
- And I gave way to a great deal of weeping because no one was found worthy to open the scroll or to look into it. (Revelation 5:4)
- But one of the elders says to me; Stop weeping. Look! The Lion that is of the tribe of Judah, the root of David, has conquered so as to open the scroll and its seven seals. (Revelation 5:5)
- Finally all the land of Egypt became famished and the people began to cry to Pharaoh for bread. Then Pharaoh said to all the Egyptians; Go to Joseph. Whatever he says to YOU, YOU are to do. (Genesis 41:55)
- Who really is the faithful and discreet slave whom his master appointed over his domestics, to give them their food at the proper time? (Matthew 24:45)
- Happy is that slave if his master on arriving finds him doing so.
 (Matthew 24:46)
- Truly I say to YOU, he will appoint him over all his belongings. (Matthew 24:47)
- Hamath, Berothah, Sibraim, which is between the boundary of Damascus and the boundary of Hamath, Hazer-hatticon, which is toward the boundary of Hauran. (Ezekiel 47:16)

- When Syria of Damascus came to help Hadadezer the king of Zobah, David then struck down among the Syrians twenty-two thousand men. (2 Samuel 8:5)
- With that he took his brothers with him and went chasing after him for a distance of seven days' journey and caught up with him in the mountainous region of Gilead. (Genesis 31:23)
- Now the sons of Reuben and the sons of Gad had come to have numerous livestock, very many, in fact. And they began to see the land of Jazer and the land of Gilead, and, look! The place was a place for livestock. (Numbers 32:1)
- Hence they shattered and heavily oppressed the sons of Israel in that year, for eighteen years all the sons of Israel that were on the side of the Jordan in the land of the Amorites that was in Gilead. (Judges 10:8)
- So Lot raised his eyes and saw the whole District of the Jordan, that all of it was a wellwatered region before Yehowah brought Sodom and Gomorrah to ruin, like the garden of Yehowah, like the land of Egypt as far as Zoar. (Genesis 13:10)
- And he went on to say to me; This water is going forth to the eastern region and must go down through the Arabah. And it must come to the sea. It being brought forth into the sea itself, its water is also actually healed. (Ezekiel 47:8)
- And the northerner I shall put far away from upon YOU, and I shall actually disperse him to a waterless land and desolated waste, with his face to the eastern sea and his rear section to the western sea. And the stink from him will certainly ascend, and the stench from him will keep ascending, for He will actually do a great thing in what He does. (Joel 2:20)
