- And I saw in the right hand of the One seated upon the throne a scroll written within and on the reverse side, sealed tight with seven seals. (**Revelation 5:1**)
- And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice; Who is worthy to open the scroll and loose its seals? (**Revelation 5:2**)
- But neither in heaven nor upon earth nor underneath the earth was there a single one able to open the scroll or to look into it. (**Revelation 5:3**)
- And I gave way to a great deal of weeping because no one was found worthy to open the scroll or to look into it. (**Revelation 5:4**)
- But one of the elders says to me; Stop weeping. Look! The Lion that is of the tribe of Judah, the root of David, has conquered so as to open the scroll and its seven seals. (**Revelation 5:5**)
- Finally all the land of Egypt became famished and the people began to cry to Pharaoh for bread. Then Pharaoh said to all the Egyptians; Go to Joseph. Whatever he says to you, you are to do. (**Genesis 41:55**)
- Who really is the faithful and discreet slave whom his master appointed over his domestics, to give them their food at the proper time? (**Matthew 24:45**)
- Happy is that slave if his master on arriving finds him doing so. (**Matthew 24:46**)
- Truly I say to you, he will appoint him over all his belongings. (**Matthew 24:47**)
- Hamath, Berothah, Sibram, which is between the boundary of Damascus and the boundary of Hamath, Hazer-hatticon, which is toward the boundary of Hauran. (**Ezekiel 47:16**)

- When Syria of **Damascus** came to help Hadadezer the king of Zobah, David then struck down among the Syrians twenty-two thousand men. (**2 Samuel 8:5**)
- With that he took his brothers with him and went chasing after him for a distance of seven days' journey and caught up with him in the mountainous region of **Gilead**. (**Genesis 31:23**)
- Now the sons of Reuben and the sons of Gad had come to have numerous livestock, very many, in fact. And they began to see the **land** of Jazer and the **land** of **Gilead**, and, look! The place was a place for livestock. (**Numbers 32:1**)
- Hence they shattered and heavily oppressed the sons of **Israel** in that year, for eighteen years all the sons of **Israel** that were on the side of the **Jordan** in the **land** of the Amorites that was in **Gilead**. (**Judges 10:8**)
- So Lot raised his eyes and saw the whole District of the **Jordan**, that all of it was a wellwatered region before Yehowah brought Sodom and Gomorrah to ruin, like the garden of Yehowah, like the **land** of Egypt as far as Zoar. (**Genesis 13:10**)
- And he went on to say to me; This water is going forth to the **eastern** region and must go down through the Arabah. And it must come to the **sea**. It being brought forth into the **sea** itself, its water is also actually healed. (**Ezekiel 47:8**)
- And the northerner I shall put far away from upon **you**, and I shall actually disperse him to a waterless **land** and desolated waste, with his face to the **eastern sea** and his rear section to the western **sea**. And the stink from him will certainly ascend, and the stench from him will keep ascending, for He will actually do a great thing in what He does. (**Joel 2:20**)
