And he gradually brought me forth by the way of the north gate and took me around by the way outside to the outer gate that is facing toward the east, and, look! Water was trickling from the right-hand side.

- Then he came to the gate, the front of which is toward the east, and went up by its steps. And he began to measure the threshold of the gate, one reed in width, and the other threshold, one reed in width. (Ezekiel 40:6)
- And the outer courtyard had a gate the front of which was toward the north. He measured its length and its width. (Ezekiel 40:20)
- Then Yehowah said to me; As regards this gate, shut is how it will continue. It will not be opened, and no mere man will come in by it, for Yehowah himself, the God of Israel, has come in by it, and it must continue shut. (Ezekiel 44:2)
