the holy contribution, ten thousand cubits to the east, and ten thousand to the west, and it must prove to be exactly as the holy contribution, and its produce must come to be for bread for the ones serving the city.

- On the ninth day of the fourth month the famine was severe in the city, and there proved to be no bread for the people of the land. (2 Kings 25:3)
- And when you people allot the land as an inheritance, you should offer a contribution to Yehowah, a holy portion out of the land, as to length, twenty-five thousand cubits in length, and as to width, ten thousand. It will be a holy portion in all its boundaries round about. (Ezekiel 45:1)
