- In that time they **will** call Jerusalem the throne of Yehowah, and to her all the nations must be brought together to the **name** of Yehowah at Jerusalem, and they **will** no more walk after the stubbornness of their bad heart. (**Jeremiah 3:17**)
- Cry out loudly and rejoice, O daughter of Zion, for here I am coming, and I **will** reside in the midst of you, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Zechariah 2:10**)
- And I **will** consider innocent their blood that I had not considered innocent, and Yehowah **will** be residing in Zion. (**Joel 3:21**)
- By reason of your saying; These two nations and these two lands, they **will** become my own, and we shall certainly take possession of each land, whereas Yehowah himself happened to be right there. (**Ezekiel 35:10**)
- As regards the five **thousand** cubits that is left remaining in width alongside the twenty-five **thousand**, it is something profane for the **city**, for a dwelling place and for pasture ground. And the **city** must come to be in the midst of it. (**Ezekiel 48:15**)
- And these are the city's measurements, the northern border four **thousand** five hundred cubits, and the southern border four **thousand** five hundred, and the eastern border four **thousand** five hundred, and the western border four **thousand** five hundred. (**Ezekiel 48:16**)
- Yehowah has removed the judgments upon you. He has turned away your enemy. The king of Israel, Yehowah, is in the midst of you. You **will** fear calamity no more. (**Zephaniah 3:15**)
- And they advanced over the breadth of the earth and encircled the camp of the holy ones and the beloved **city**. But fire came down out of heaven and devoured them. (**Revelation 20:9**)

- **With that I heard a loud voice from the throne say; Look! The tent of God is with mankind, and he **will** reside with them, and they **will** be his peoples. And God himself **will** be with them. (Revelation 21:3)**
