And you, O Son of Man, take for yourself a brick, and you must put it before you and engrave upon it a city, even Jerusalem.

- Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the killer of the prophets and stoner of those sent forth to her, how often I wanted to gather your children together, the way a hen gathers her chicks together under her wings! But you people did not want it. (Matthew 23:37)
- Hear, you deaf ones, and look forth to see, you blind ones. (Isaiah 42:18)
- Who is blind, if not my servant, and who is deaf as my messenger whom I send? Who is blind as the one rewarded, or blind as the servant of Yehowah? (Isaiah 42:19)
