

Ezekiel 4:14

And I proceeded to say; Alas, O Sovereign Lord Yehowah! Look! My soul is not a defiled one, neither a body already dead nor a torn animal have I eaten from my youth up, even until now, and into my mouth there has come no foul flesh.

[16] - References:

- My **soul** he refreshes. He leads me in the tracks of righteousness for his name's sake (**Psalms 23:3**)
- Even though I walk in the valley of deep shadow, I fear nothing bad, for you are with me, your rod and your staff are the things that comfort me. (**Psalms 23:4**)
- But Peter said; Not at all, **Lord**, because never **have I eaten** anything **defiled** and unclean. (**Acts of Apostles 10:14**)
- And **you** should prove yourselves holy men to me, and **you** must not eat **flesh** in the field that is something **torn** by a wild beast. **You** should throw it to the dogs. (**Exodus 22:31**)
- Now the fat of a body already **dead** and the fat of an **animal torn** to pieces may be used for anything else conceivable, but **you** must not eat it at all. (**Leviticus 7:24**)
- And he who eats any of its **dead** body will wash his garments, and he must be unclean **until** the evening, and he who carries off its **dead** body will wash his garments, and he must be unclean **until** the evening. (**Leviticus 11:40**)
- However, if any of the **flesh** of his communion sacrifice should at all be **eaten** on the third day, the one presenting it will not be accepted with approval. It will not be put to his account. It will become a **foul** thing, and the **soul** that eats some of it will answer for his error. (**Leviticus 7:18**)
- You must eat no detestable thing of any sort. (**Deuteronomy 14:3**)
- Seating themselves among the burial places, who also pass the night **even** in the watch huts, eating the **flesh** of the pig, **even** the broth of **foul** things being in their vessels. (**Isaiah 65:4**)
- Those sanctifying themselves and cleansing themselves for the gardens behind one in the center, eating the **flesh** of the pig and

- the loathsome thing, **even** the jumping rodent, they will all together reach their end, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Isaiah 66:17**)
- If it should for a fact be **torn** by a wild beast, he is to bring it as evidence. For something **torn** by a wild beast he is not to make compensation. (**Exodus 22:13**)
 - And in case a **soul** touches anything unclean, the uncleanness of a man or an unclean beast or any unclean loathsome thing, and actually eats some of the **flesh** of the communion sacrifice, which is for Yehowah, that **soul** must be cut off from his people. (**Leviticus 7:21**)
 - Speak to the sons of Israel, saying; This is the living creature that **you** may eat of all the beasts that are upon the earth. (**Leviticus 11:2**)
 - If, though, it should at all be **eaten** on the third day, it is a **foul** thing. It will not be accepted with approval. (**Leviticus 19:7**)
 - **You** must not eat any body already **dead**. To the alien resident who is inside your gates you may give it, and he must eat it, or there may be a selling of it to a foreigner, because you are a holy people to Yehowah your God. You must not boil a kid in its mother's milk. (**Deuteronomy 14:21**)
 - In time a great famine arose in Samaria, and, look! They were besieging it **until** an ass's head got to be worth eighty silver pieces, and the fourth of a cab measure of dove's dung was worth five silver pieces. (**2 Kings 6:25**)
 - But I said; Not at all, **Lord**, because a **defiled** or unclean thing **has** never entered into my mouth. (**Acts of Apostles 11:8**)
