[4] - References:

- Render to her even as she herself rendered, and do to her twice as much, yes, twice the number of the things she did, in the cup in which she **put** a mixture **put** twice as much of the mixture for her. (**Revelation 18:6**)
- To the extent that she glorified herself and lived in shameless luxury, to that extent give her torment and mourning. For in her heart she keeps saying, I sit a queen, and I am no widow, and I shall never see mourning. (**Revelation 18:7**)
- That is why in one day her plagues will come, death and mourning and famine, and she will be completely burned with fire, because Yehowah God, who judged her, is strong. (**Revelation 18:8**)
- Before their eyes you will do the carrying on the shoulder itself. During the darkness you will do the bringing out. You will cover your very **face** that you may not see the earth, because a portent is what I have made you to the **house** of **Israel**. (**Ezekiel 12:6**)
- And Ezekiel has become for **you** a portent. In accord with all that he has done, **you** will do. When it comes, **you** will also have to know that I am the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 24:24**)
- In his right hand the divination proved to be for Jerusalem, to set battering rams, to open one's mouth for a slaying, to raise the sound in an alarm signal, to set battering rams **against** gates, to throw up a **siege** rampart, to build a **siege wall**. (**Ezekiel 21:22**)
