[2] - References:

- He was despised and was avoided by men, a man meant for pains and for having acquaintance with sickness. And there was as if the concealing of one's face from us. He was despised, and we held him as of no account. (**Isaiah 53:3**)
- Truly our sicknesses were what he himself carried, and as for our pains, he bore them. But we ourselves accounted him as plagued, stricken by God and afflicted. (**Isaiah 53:4**)
- Like sheep we have all of us wandered about, it was each one to his own way that we have turned, and Yehowah himself has caused the **error** of us all to meet up with that one. (**Isaiah 53:6**)
- For he ripped **Israel** off from the **house** of David, and they proceeded to make Jeroboam the son of Nebat king, and Jeroboam proceeded to part **Israel** from following Yehowah, and he caused them to sin with a great sin. (**2 Kings 17:21**)
