

Ezekiel 5:10¹ **Therefore fathers themselves will eat sons in the midst of you, and sons themselves will eat their fathers, and I will execute in you acts of judgment and scatter all the remainder of you to every wind.¹**

Footnote: Wind Hebrew, *ru'ach*; Greek, *a'ne-mon*; Latin, *ven'tum* That is, every direction to which the wind blows

[17] - References:

- Look! There are days coming, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, and I **will** send a famine into the land, a famine, not for bread, and a thirst, not for water, but for hearing the words of Yehowah. (**Amos 8:11**)
- And they **will** certainly stagger from sea all the way to sea, and from north even to the sunrise. They **will** keep roving about while searching for the word of Yehowah, but they **will** not find it. (**Amos 8:12**)
- So **YOU will** have to **eat** the flesh of **YOUR sons**, and **YOU will eat** the flesh of **YOUR** daughters. (**Leviticus 26:29**)
- Then you **will** have to **eat** the fruit of your belly, the flesh of your **sons** and your daughters, whom Yehowah your God has given you, because of the tightness and stress with which your enemy **will** hem you in. (**Deuteronomy 28:53**)
- Accordingly we boiled my son and ate him. Then I said to her on the next day, Give your son that we may **eat** him. But she hid her son. (**2 Kings 6:29**)
- And I **will** make them **eat** the flesh of their **sons** and the flesh of their daughters, and they **will eat** each one the flesh of his fellowman, because of the tightness and because of the stress with which their enemies and those seeking for their soul **will** hem them in. (**Jeremiah 19:9**)
- See, O Yehowah, and do look to the one to whom you have dealt severely in this manner. Should the women keep eating their own fruitage, the children born fully formed, or in the sanctuary of Yehowah should priest and prophet be killed? (**Lamentations 2:20**)

- The very hands of compassionate women have boiled their own children. They have become as bread of consolation to one during the breakdown of the daughter of my people. (**Lamentations 4:10**)
- And **you** I shall **scatter** among the nations, and I **will** unsheathe a sword after **you**, and **your** land must become a desolation, and **your** cities **will** become a desolate ruin. (**Leviticus 26:33**)
- And Yehowah **will** certainly **scatter** **you** among the peoples, and **you** **will** indeed be let remain few in number among the nations to which Yehowah **will** drive **you** away. (**Deuteronomy 4:27**)
- And Yehowah **will** certainly **scatter** you among all the peoples from the one end of the earth to the other end of the earth, and there you **will** have to serve other gods whom you have not known, neither you nor your forefathers, wood and stone. (**Deuteronomy 28:64**)
- Remember, please, the word that you commanded Moses your servant, saying, Should **you**, for **your** part, act unfaithfully, I, for my part, shall **scatter** **you** among the peoples. (**Nehemiah 1:8**)
- And all who are round about him as a help, and all his military bands, I shall **scatter** to every **wind**, and a sword I shall draw out after them. (**Ezekiel 12:14**)
- And as regards all the fugitives of his in all his bands, by the sword they **will** fall, and the ones left remaining **will** be spread abroad even to every **wind**. And **you** people **will** have to know that I myself, Yehowah, have spoken it. (**Ezekiel 17:21**)
- And the king went on to say to her; What is the matter with you? So she said; This very woman said to me; Give your son that we may **eat** him today, and my own son we shall **eat** tomorrow. (**2 Kings 6:28**)
- On the ninth day of the fourth month the famine was severe in the city, and there proved to be no bread for the people of the land. (**2 Kings 25:3**)
- And I **will** bring in upon Elam the four **winds** from the four extremities of the heavens. And I **will** **scatter** them to all these **winds**, and there **will** prove to be no nation to which the dispersed ones of Elam **will** not come. (**Jeremiah 49:36**)

- **At length I said; I shall not keep shepherding you. The one that is dying, let her die. And the one that is being effaced, let her be effaced. And as for the ones left remaining, let them devour, each one the flesh of her companion. (Zechariah 11:9)**
