judicial decisions in wickedness more than the nations, and against my statutes more than the lands that are all around her, for my judicial decisions they rejected and, as for my statutes, they did not walk in them.

- And it was not in their ways that you walked, nor according to their detestable things that you did. In a very little while you even began to act more ruinously than they did in all your ways. (Ezekiel 16:47)
- And they themselves, even our forefathers, acted presumptuously and proceeded to harden their neck, and they did not listen to your commandments. (Nehemiah 9:16)
- They did not keep the covenant of God, and in his Law they refused to walk. (Psalms 78:10)

- Why is it that this people, Jerusalem, is unfaithful with an enduring unfaithfulness? They have taken hold of trickiness, they have refused to turn back. (Jeremiah 8:5)
- They have returned to the errors of their forefathers, the first ones, who refused to obey my words, but who themselves have walked after other gods in order to serve them. The house of Israel and the house of Judah have broken my covenant that I concluded with their forefathers. (Jeremiah 11:10)
- For our revolts have become many in front of you, and as for our sins, each one has testified against us. For our revolts are with us, and as for our errors, we well know them. (Isaiah 59:12)
- Son of man, make known to Jerusalem her detestable things. (Ezekiel 16:2)
- And, look! I shall certainly stretch out my hand against you and I shall diminish your allowance and give you to the soulful desire of the women hating you, the daughters of the Philistines, the women humiliated on account of your way as regards loose conduct. (Ezekiel 16:27)
