Ezekiel 5:7" Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; For the reason that you people were more turbulent¹ than the nations that are all around you, in my statutes you did not walk and my judicial decisions you did not perform, but according to the judicial decisions of the nations that are all around you, you performed, did you not?

- And it was not in their ways that you walked, nor according to their detestable things that you did. In a very little while you even began to act more ruinously than they did in all your ways. (Ezekiel 16:47)

And I proceeded to say to their sons in the wilderness, In the regulations of your forefathers do not you walk, and their judgments do not you keep, and with their dungy idols do not you defile yourselves. (Ezekiel 20:18)
