Ezekiel 6:13... And you people will have to know that I am Yehowah, when their slain ones come to be in the midst of their dungy idols, all around their altars, upon every high hill, on all the tops of the mountains and under every luxuriant tree and under every branchy big tree, the place where they have offered a restful odor to all their dungy idols.

- And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice; Who is worthy to open the scroll and loose its seals? (Revelation 5:2)
- But neither in heaven nor upon earth nor underneath the earth was there a single one able to open the scroll or to look into it. (Revelation 5:3)
- And I gave way to a great deal of weeping because no one was found worthy to open the scroll or to look into it. (Revelation 5:4)
- But one of the elders says to me; Stop weeping. Look! The Lion that is of the tribe of Judah, the root of David, has conquered so as to open the scroll and its seven seals. (Revelation 5:5)
- Who really is the faithful and discreet slave whom his master appointed over his domestics, to give them their food at the proper time? (Matthew 24:45)
- Happy is that slave if his master on arriving finds him doing so.
  (Matthew 24:46)
- Truly I say to YOU, he will appoint him over all his belongings. (Matthew 24:47)
- A son, for his part, honors a father, and a servant, his grand master. So if I am a father, where is the honor to me? And if I am a grand master, where is the fear of me? Yehowah of armies

has said to YOU, O priests who are despising my name. And YOU have said; In what way have we despised your name? (Malachi 1:6)

- By presenting upon my altar polluted bread. And you have said; In what way have we polluted you? By your saying; The table of Yehowah is something to be despised. (Malachi 1:7)
- And when you present a blind animal for sacrificing; It is nothing bad. And when you present a lame animal or a sick one; It is nothing bad. Bring it near, please, to your governor. Will he find pleasure in you, or will he receive you kindly? Yehowah of armies has said. (Malachi 1:8)
- And they will have to know that I am Yehowah when I disperse them among the nations and I actually scatter them among the lands. (Ezekiel 12:15)
- And I shall certainly magnify myself and sanctify myself and make myself known before the eyes of many nations, and they will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 38:23)
- And YOUR altars must be made desolate and YOUR incense stands must be broken, and I will cause YOUR slain ones to fall before YOUR dungy idols. (Ezekiel 6:4)
- And they will actually spread them out to the sun and to the moon and to all the army of the heavens that they have loved and that they have served and that they have walked after and that they have sought and that they have bowed down to. They will not be gathered, nor will they be buried. As manure upon the face of the ground they will become. (Jeremiah 8:2)
- You should absolutely destroy all the places where the nations whom you are dispossessing have served their gods, on the tall mountains and the hills and under every luxuriant tree. (Deuteronomy 12:2)
- For their own errors and for the errors of their forefathers at the same time; Yehowah has said. Because they have made sacrificial smoke upon the mountains, and upon the hills they have reproached me, I will also measure out their wages first of all into their own bosom. (Isaiah 65:7)
- For long ago I broke your yoke to pieces, I tore your bands apart. But you said; I am not going to serve, for upon every high hill

- and under every luxuriant tree you were lying sprawled out, prostituting yourself. (Jeremiah 2:20)
- And I proceeded to bring them into the land that I had lifted up my hand in an oath to give them. When they got to see every exalted hill and every branchy tree, then they began sacrificing there their sacrifices and giving there their offensive offering, and presenting there their restful odors and pouring out there their drink offerings. (Ezekiel 20:28)
- And Yehowah proceeded to say to me in the days of Josiah the king; Have you seen what unfaithful Israel has done? She is going upon every high mountain and underneath every luxuriant tree, that she may commit prostitution there. (Jeremiah 3:6)
- On the tops of the mountains they sacrifice, and on the hills they make sacrificial smoke, under massive tree and storax tree and big tree, because its shade is good. That is why YOUR daughters commit fornication and YOUR own daughters-in-law commit adultery. (Hosea 4:13)
- And they too kept building for themselves high places and sacred pillars and sacred poles upon every high hill and under every luxuriant tree. (1 Kings 14:23)
- Those who are working up passion among big trees, under every luxuriant tree, slaughtering the children in the torrent valleys under the clefts of the crags? (Isaiah 57:5)
- The people made up of those offending me right to my face constantly, sacrificing in the gardens and making sacrificial smoke upon the bricks. (Isaiah 65:3)
- For they will be ashamed of the mighty trees that you people desired, and you will be abashed because of the gardens that you have chosen. (Isaiah 1:29)
- Your acts of adultery and your neighings, your loose conduct in prostitution. Upon the hills, in the field, I have seen your disgusting things. Woe to you, O Jerusalem! You cannot be clean, after how much longer? (Jeremiah 13:27)
- When their sons remember their altars and their sacred poles beside a luxuriant tree, upon the high hills. (Jeremiah 17:2)

- And my eye will not feel sorry for you, neither will I feel compassion, for upon you I shall bring your own ways, and in the midst of you your own detestable things will come to be, and you people will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 7:4)
- The king himself will go into mourning, even a chieftain will clothe himself with desolation, and the very hands of the people of the land will get disturbed. According to their way I shall act toward them, and with their judgments I shall judge them, and they will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 7:27)
- By the sword You will fall. On the border of Israel I shall judge You people, and You will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 11:10)
- And the inhabited cities themselves will be devastated, and the land itself will become a mere desolate waste, and you will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 12:20)
- And my hand has come to be against the prophets that are visioning untruth and that are divining a lie.
