

Ezekiel 6:2 Son of Man, set your face toward the mountains of Israel and prophesy to them.

[7] - References:

- Son of man, set your face in the direction of the southern quarter and drip words to the south, and prophesy to the forest of the field of the south (**Ezekiel 20:46**)
- Son of man, set your face toward Jerusalem and drip words toward the holy places, and prophesy against the soil of Israel. (**Ezekiel 21:2**)
- And I shall actually make the land a desolate waste, even a desolation, and the pride of its strength must be made to cease and the mountains of Israel must be laid desolate, with no one passing through. (**Ezekiel 33:28**)
- And as for you, O son of man, prophesy concerning the mountains of Israel, and you must say, O mountains of Israel, hear the word of Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 36:1**)
- Finally they put him in the cage by means of hooks and brought him to the king of Babylon. They got to bring him by means of hunting nets, in order that his voice might no more be heard on the mountains of Israel. (**Ezekiel 19:9**)
- Son of man, set your face against the mountainous region of Seir and prophesy against it. (**Ezekiel 35:2**)
- Therefore, O mountains of Israel, hear the word of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah! This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said to the mountains and to the hills, to the streambeds and to the valleys and to the devastated places that were laid desolate and to the abandoned cities that have come to be for plunder and for ridicule to the remaining ones of the nations that are round about.
