And you must say, O mountains of Israel, hear the word of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said to the mountains and to the hills, to the streambeds and to the valleys; Here I am! I am bringing upon you a sword, and I shall certainly destroy your high places.

- And earthling man will bow down, and man will become low, and even the eyes of the **high** ones will become low. (**Isaiah 5:15**)
- The haughty eyes of earthling man must become low, and the loftiness of men must bow down, and Yehowah alone must be put on **high** in that day. (**Isaiah 2:11**)
- Hear, O **you mountains**, the legal case of Yehowah, also **you** durable objects, **you** foundations of the earth, for Yehowah **has** a legal case with his people, and it is with **Israel** that he will argue. (**Micah 6:2**)
- Truly the **hills** as well as the turmoil on the **mountains** belong to falsehood. Truly in Yehowah our God is the salvation of **Israel**. (**Jeremiah 3:23**)
- On the **mountains** in the field. Your resources, all your treasures, I shall give for mere plunder, your **high places** because of sin throughout all your territories. (**Jeremiah 17:3**)
- And I shall **certainly** annihilate **your** sacred **high places** and cut off **your** incense stands and lay **your** own carcasses upon the carcasses of **your** dungy idols, and my soul will simply abhor **you**. (**Leviticus 26:30**)
- And the **high places** themselves did not disappear from **Israel**. Only Asa's heart itself proved to be complete all his days. (**2 Chronicles 15:17**)
- And Yehowah proceeded to **say** to me in the days of Josiah the king; Have you seen **what** unfaithful **Israel has** done? She is going upon every **high** mountain and underneath every luxuriant tree, that she may commit prostitution there. (**Jeremiah 3:6**)
- And the hand of Yehowah came to be upon me there and he proceeded to **say** to me; Get up, go forth to the valley plain, and there I shall speak with you. (**Ezekiel 3:22**)

- **Son of man, set your face toward Jerusalem and drip words toward the holy places, and prophesy against the soil of Israel. (Ezekiel 21:2)**
- **Son of man, speak to the sons of your people, and you must say to them; As regards a land, in case I bring upon it a sword and the people of the land, one and all, actually take a man and set him as their watchman. (Ezekiel 33:2)**
- **And I shall actually make the land a desolate waste, even a desolation, and the pride of its strength must be made to cease and the mountains of Israel must be laid desolate, with no one passing through. (Ezekiel 33:28)**
