**In all YOUR dwelling places the very cities will become devastated and the high places themselves will become desolated, in order that they may lie devastated and YOUR altars may lie desolated and be actually broken and YOUR dungy idols may be actually made to cease and YOUR incense stands cut down and YOUR works wiped out.**

- Well, I John was the one hearing and seeing these things. And when I had heard and seen, I fell **down** to worship before the feet of the angel that had been showing me these things. (**Revelation 22:8**)
- You must not bow **down** to them nor be induced to serve them, because I Yehowah your God am a God exacting exclusive devotion, bringing punishment for the error of fathers upon sons, upon the third generation and upon the fourth generation, in the case of those who hate me. (**Exodus 20:5**)
- Having a form of godly devotion but proving false to its power, and from these turn away. (**2 Timothy 3:5**)
- For the voice of lamentation is what has been heard from Zion; How we have been despoiled! How much we have felt shame! For we have left the land, for they have thrown away our residences. (**Jeremiah 9:19**)
- And the Chaldeans who are fighting against this city must come in and set this city aflame with fire and must burn it **down** and the houses upon the roofs of which they have **made** sacrificial smoke to Baal and have poured **out** drink offerings to other gods for the purpose of offending me. (**Jeremiah 32:29**)
- For the **dwelling** tower itself has been forsaken, the very hubbub of the city has been abandoned, Ophel and the watchtower themselves have **become** bare fields, for time indefinite the exultation of zebras, the pasture of droves. (**Isaiah 32:14**)
- Against him maned young lions roar, they have given **out** their voice. And they went making his land an object of astonishment. His own **cities** have been set afire, so that there is no inhabitant. (**Jeremiah 2:15**)

- Therefore on account of **you** men Zion **will** be plowed up as a mere field, and Jerusalem herself **will become** mere heaps of ruins, and the mountain of the house **will** be as the **high places** of a forest. (**Micah 3:12**)
- On the mountains in the field. Your resources, all your treasures, I shall give for mere plunder, your **high places** because of sin throughout all your territories. (**Jeremiah 17:3**)
- And I **will** give you into their hand, and they **will** certainly tear **down** your mound and your heights **will** certainly be pulled **down**, and they must strip you of your garments and take your beautiful articles and leave you behind naked and nude. (**Ezekiel 16:39**)
- Their heart has **become** hypocritical, now they **will** be found guilty. There is one who **will** break their **altars**, he **will** despoil their pillars. (**Hosea 10:2**)
- And her graven images **will** all be crushed to pieces, and all the gifts **made** to her as her hire **will** be burned in the fire, and all her **idols** I shall make a desolate waste. For from the things given as the hire of a prostitute she collected them, and to the thing given as the hire of a prostitute they **will** return. (**Micah 1:7**)
- Look! Yehowah is emptying the land and laying it waste, and he has twisted the face of it and scattered its inhabitants. (**Isaiah 24:1**)
