And your escaped ones will certainly remember me among the nations to which they will have been taken captive, because I have been broken up at their fornicating heart that has turned aside from me and at their eyes that are going in fornication after their dungy idols, and they will certainly feel a loathing in their faces at the bad things that they have done in all their detestable things.

- Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the killer of the prophets and stoner of those sent forth to her, how often I wanted to gather your children together, the way a hen gathers her chicks together under her wings! But you people did not want it. (Matthew 23:37)
- Look! Your house is abandoned to you. (Matthew 23:38)
- For I say to you, you will by no means see me from henceforth until you say, Blessed is he that comes in Yehowah's name! (Matthew 23:39)
- Therefore, in answer, Jesus went on to say to them; Most truly I say to You, the Son cannot do a single thing of his own initiative, but only what he beholds the Father doing. For whatever things that One does, these things the Son also does in like manner. (John 5:19)
- Therefore Jesus said; When once you have lifted up the Son of man, then you will know that I am he, and that I do nothing of my own initiative, but just as the Father taught me I speak these things. (John 8:28)
- You worship what you do not know, we worship what we know, because salvation originates with the Jews. (John 4:22)
- Nevertheless, the hour is coming, and it is now, when the true worshipers will worship the Father with spirit and truth, for, indeed, the Father is looking for suchlike ones to worship him. (John 4:23)
- God is a Spirit, and those worshiping him must worship with spirit and truth. (John 4:24)

- You yourself will arise, you will have mercy on Zion, for it is the season to be favorable to her, for the appointed time has come. (Psalms 102:13)
- For your servants have found pleasure in her stones, and to her dust they direct their favor. (Psalms 102:14)
- He will certainly turn to the prayer of those stripped of everything, and not despise their prayer. (Psalms 102:17)
- This is written for the future generation, and the people that is to be created will praise Yah. (Psalms 102:18)
- And it must occur that when all these words will come upon you, the blessing and the malediction, which I have put before you, and you have brought them back to your heart among all the nations where Yehowah your God has dispersed you.

- By the rivers of Babylon, there we sat down. We also wept when we remembered Zion. (Psalms 137:1)
- And I will leave remaining from them a few men from the sword, from the famine and from the pestilence, in order that they may recount all their detestable things among the nations to whom they must come in, and they will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 12:16)
- And I shall scatter them like seed among the peoples, and in the distant places they will remember me, and they must revive with their sons and return. (Zechariah 10:9)
- How often they would rebel against him in the wilderness, they would make him feel hurt in the desert! (Psalms 78:40)
- And he proceeded to say; Listen, please, O house of David. Is it such a little thing for you to tire out men, that you should also tire out my God? (Isaiah 7:13)
- But they themselves rebelled and made his Holy Spirit feel hurt. He now was changed into an enemy of theirs, he himself warred against them. (Isaiah 63:10)
- And it must serve as a fringed edge for You, and You must see it and remember all the commandments of Yehowah and do them,

- and you must not go about following your hearts and your eyes, which you are following in immoral intercourse. (Numbers 15:39)
- And I went on to say to them; Throw away, each one of YOU, the disgusting things of his eyes, and with the dungy idols of Egypt do not defile yourselves. I am Yehowah YOUR God. (Ezekiel 20:7)
- And we become like someone unclean, all of us, and all our acts of righteousness are like a garment for periods of menstruation, and we shall fade away like leafage, all of us, and our errors themselves will carry us away just like a wind. (Isaiah 64:6)
- And you will certainly remember there your ways and all your dealings by which you defiled yourselves, and you will actually feel a loathing at your own faces because of all your bad things that you did. (Ezekiel 20:43)
- And you will be bound to remember your bad ways and your dealings that were not good, and you will be bound to feel a loathing at your own person on account of your errors and on account of your detestable things. (Ezekiel 36:31)
- For fear that you may conclude a covenant with the inhabitants of the land, as they will certainly have immoral intercourse with their gods and sacrifice to their gods, and someone will be certain to invite you, and you will certainly eat some of his sacrifice. (Exodus 34:15)
- As for the soul who turns himself to the spirit mediums and the professional foretellers of events so as to have immoral intercourse with them, I shall certainly set my face against that soul and cut him off from among his people. (Leviticus 20:6)
- As for those remaining among YOU, they will rot away because of their error in the lands of YOUR enemies. Yes, even because of the errors of their fathers, with them they will rot away. (Leviticus 26:39)
- Then Hanani, one of my brothers, came in, he and other men from Judah, and I proceeded to ask them about the Jews, those who had escaped, who had been left over of the captivity, and also about Jerusalem. (Nehemiah 1:2)
- If my stepping deviates from the way, or my heart has walked merely after my eyes, or any defect has stuck in my own palms. (Job 31:7)
