Ezekiel 7:10" Look! The day! Look! It is coming. The garland has gone forth. The rod has blossomed. Presumptuousness has sprouted.

- And it came about the next day that when Moses went into the tent of the Testimony, look! Aaron's rod for the house of Levi had budded, and it was bringing forth buds and blossoming flowers and was bearing ripe almonds. (Numbers 17:8)
- Finally all the land of Egypt became famished and the people began to cry to Pharaoh for bread. Then Pharaoh said to all the Egyptians; Go to Joseph. Whatever he says to You, You are to do. (Genesis 41:55)
- Hey there, all you thirsty ones! Come to the water. And the ones that have no money! Come, buy and eat. Yes, come, buy wine and milk even without money and without price. (Isaiah 55:1)
- Why do you people keep paying out money for what is not bread, and why is your toil for what results in no satisfaction? Listen intently to me, and eat what is good, and let your soul find its exquisite delight in fatness itself. (Isaiah 55:2)
- Incline YOUR ear and come to me. Listen, and YOUR soul will keep alive, and I shall readily conclude with YOU people an indefinitely lasting covenant respecting the loving-kindnesses to David that are faithful. (Isaiah 55:3)
- Look! As a witness to the national groups I have given him, as a leader and commander to the national groups. (Isaiah 55:4)
- Look! A nation that you do not know you will call, and those of a nation who have not known you will run even to you, for the sake of Yehowah your God, and for the Holy One of Israel, because he will have beautified you. (Isaiah 55:5)
- The great day of Yehowah is near. It is near, and there is a hurrying of it very much. The sound of the day of Yehowah is bitter. There a mighty man is letting out a cry. (Zephaniah 1:14)
- The garland must come to you, O inhabiter of the land, the time must come, the day is near. There is confusion, and not the shouting of the mountains. (Ezekiel 7:7)

- Aha, the Assyrian, the rod for my anger, and the stick that is in their hand for my denunciation! (Isaiah 10:5)
- Look! I am against you, O Presumptuousness, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord, Yehowah of armies, for your day must come, the time that I must give you attention (Jeremiah 50:31)
- Therefore my people will have to go into exile for lack of knowledge, and their glory will be famished men, and their crowd will be parched with thirst. (Isaiah 5:13)
- And I will make you pass under the rod and bring you into the bond of the covenant. (Ezekiel 20:37)
