

Ezekiel 7:15 The sword is outside, and the pestilence and the famine are inside. Whoever is in the field, by the sword he will die, and whoever are in the city, famine and pestilence themselves will devour them.

[16] - References:

- And when he got nearby, he viewed the **city** and wept over it. (**Luke 19:41**)
- Saying; If you, even you, had discerned in this day the things having to do with peace, but now they have been hid from your eyes. (**Luke 19:42**)
- Because the days **will** come upon you when your enemies **will** build around you a fortification with pointed stakes and **will** encircle you and distress you from every side. (**Luke 19:43**)
- And they **will** dash you and your children within you to the ground, and they **will** not leave a stone upon a stone in you, because you did not discern the time of your being inspected. (**Luke 19:44**)
- And out of his mouth there protrudes a sharp long **sword**, that he may strike the nations with it, and he **will** shepherd them with a rod of iron. He treads too the winepress of the anger of the wrath of God the Almighty. (**Revelation 19:15**)
- But if ever that evil slave should say in his heart; My master is delaying. (**Matthew 24:48**)
- And should start to beat his fellow slaves and should eat and drink with the confirmed drunkards. (**Matthew 24:49**)
- The master of that slave **will** come on a day that he does not expect and in an hour that he does not know. (**Matthew 24:50**)
- And **will** punish him with the greatest severity and **will** assign him his part with the hypocrites. There is where his weeping and the gnashing of his teeth **will** be. (**Matthew 24:51**)
- Your own prophets have visioned for you worthless and unsatisfying things. And they have not uncovered your error in order to turn back your captivity. But they kept visioning for you worthless and misleading pronouncements. (**Lamentations 2:14**)

- And I shall certainly bring upon **you** a **sword** wreaking vengeance for the covenant, and **you will** indeed gather yourselves into **YOUR** cities, and I shall certainly send **pestilence** into the midst of **you**, and **you** must be given into the hand of an enemy. (**Leviticus 26:25**)
- Outdoors a **sword will** bereave them, and indoors fright, of both young man and virgin, suckling together with gray-haired man. (**Deuteronomy 32:25**)
- The one sitting still in this **city will die** by the **sword** and by the **famine** and by the **pestilence**, but the one who is going out and who actually falls away to the Chaldeans who are laying siege against **you will** keep living, and his soul **will** certainly come to be his as a spoil. (**Jeremiah 21:9**)
- Why should you yourself and your people **die** by the **sword**, by the **famine** and by the **pestilence** according to what Yehowah has spoken to the nation that does not serve the king of Babylon? (**Jeremiah 27:13**)
- See, O Yehowah, for I am in sore straits. My very intestines are in a ferment. My heart has been overturned in the midst of me, for I have been absolutely rebellious. Outside the **sword** caused bereavement of children. Within the house it is the same as death. (**Lamentations 1:20**)
- If I actually go out into the **field**, look, now, those slain by the **sword**! And if I actually come into the **city**, look, also, the maladies from the **famine**! For both the prophet and the priest themselves have gone around to a land that they have not known. (**Jeremiah 14:18**)
- And it must occur that should they say to you, Where shall we go out to? You must also say to them, This is what Yehowah has said; Whoever is for deadly plague, to deadly plague! And whoever is for the **sword**, to the **sword**! And whoever is for the **famine**, to the **famine**! And whoever is for the captivity, to the captivity! (**Jeremiah 15:2**)
- A third of you, by the **pestilence** they **will die**, and by **famine** they **will** come to their end in the midst of you. And another third, by the **sword** they **will** fall all around you. And the last third I shall scatter even to every wind, and a **sword** is what I shall draw out after them. (**Ezekiel 5:12**)

- On the ninth day of the fourth month the **famine** was severe in the **city**, and there proved to be no bread for the people of the land. (**2 Kings 25:3**)
- And I **will** strike the inhabitants of this **city**, both man and beast. With a great **pestilence** they **will die**. (**Jeremiah 21:6**)
- And I **will** send against them the **sword**, the **famine** and the **pestilence**, until they come to their finish off the ground that I gave to them and to their forefathers. (**Jeremiah 24:10**)
- This is what Yehowah has said; The one continuing to dwell in this **city** is the one that **will die** by the **sword**, by the **famine** and by the **pestilence**. But the one going out to the Chaldeans is the one that **will** keep living and that **will** certainly come to have his soul as a spoil and alive. (**Jeremiah 38:2**)
