- Therefore, when **you** catch sight of the disgusting thing that causes desolation, as spoken of through Daniel the prophet, standing in a holy place, let the reader use discernment. (**Matthew 24:15**)
- Then let those in Judea begin fleeing to the mountains. (**Matthew 24:16**)
- Let the man on the housetop not come down to take the goods out of his house. (**Matthew 24:17**)
- And let the man in the field not return to the house to pick up his outer garment. (**Matthew 24:18**)
- Woe to the pregnant women and those suckling a baby in those days! (**Matthew 24:19**)
- Keep praying that **your** flight may not occur in wintertime, nor on the Sabbath day. (**Matthew 24:20**)
- For then there will be great tribulation such as **has** not occurred since the world's beginning until now, no, nor will occur again. (**Matthew 24:21**)
- In fact, unless those days were cut short, no flesh would be saved, but on account of the chosen ones those days will be cut short. (**Matthew 24:22**)
- Furthermore, when **you** see Jerusalem surrounded by encamped armies, then know that the desolating of her **has** drawn near. (**Luke 21:20**)

- Then let those in Judea begin fleeing to the mountains, and let those in the midst of her withdraw, and let those in the country places not enter into her. (**Luke 21:21**)
- And when he got nearby, he viewed the **city** and wept over it. (**Luke 19:41**)
- Saying; If you, even you, had discerned in this day the things having to do with peace, but now they have been hid from your eyes. (**Luke 19:42**)
- Because the days will come upon you when your enemies will build around you a fortification with pointed stakes and will encircle you and distress you from every side. (**Luke 19:43**)
- And they will dash you and your children within you to the ground, and they will not leave a stone upon a stone in you, because you did not discern the time of your being inspected. (**Luke 19:44**)
- This is what Yehowah **has** said to me; Make for yourself bands and yoke bars, and you must put them upon your neck. (**Jeremiah 27:2**)
- And the eyes of Zedekiah he blinded, after which he bound him with copper fetters, in order to bring him to Babylon. (**Jeremiah 39:7**)
- The word that occurred to Jeremiah from Yehowah after Nebuzaradan the chief of the bodyguard sent him from Ramah, when he took him while he was bound with handcuffs in the midst of all the exiles of Jerusalem and of Judah, who were being taken into exile in Babylon. (**Jeremiah 40:1**)
- He **has** blocked me up as with a stone wall, that I may not go forth. He **has** made my copper fetters heavy. (**Lamentations 3:7**)
- She, too, was meant for exile, she went into captivity. Her own children also came to be dashed to pieces at the head of all the streets, and over her glorified men they cast lots, and her great ones have all been bound with fetters. (**Nahum 3:10**)
- And there was also innocent blood that Manasseh shed in very great quantity, until he had filled Jerusalem from end to end, besides his sin with which he caused Judah to sin by doing what was bad in the eyes of Yehowah. (**2 Kings 21:16**)

- And also for the innocent blood that he had shed, so that he filled Jerusalem with innocent blood, and Yehowah did not consent to grant forgiveness. (2 Kings 24:4)
- Also, in your skirts there have been found the blood marks of the souls of the innocent poor ones. Not in the act of breaking in have I found them, but they are upon all these. (Jeremiah 2:34)
- Assuredly your eyes and your heart are upon nothing but upon your unjust gain, and upon the blood of the innocent one in order to shed it, and upon defrauding and upon extortion in order to carry them on. (Jeremiah 22:17)
- So he said to me; The error of the house of Israel and Judah is very, very great, and the land is filled with bloodshed and the city is full of crookedness, for they have said, Yehowah has left the land, and Yehowah is not seeing. (Ezekiel 9:9)
- You have caused your slain ones in this city to be many, and you have filled her streets with the slain ones. (Ezekiel 11:6)
- There are the pronouncing of curses and practicing of deception and murdering and stealing and committing of adultery that have broken forth, and acts of bloodshed have touched other acts of bloodshed. (Hosea 4:2)
- Their mere cobweb will not serve as a garment, nor will they cover themselves with their works. Their works are hurtful works, and the activity of violence is in their palms. (Isaiah 59:6)
- And they have desired fields and have seized them, also houses, and have taken them, and they have defrauded an able-bodied man and his household, a man and his hereditary possession. (Micah 2:2)
- For your own palms have become polluted with blood, and your fingers with error. Your own lips have spoken falsehood. Your own tongue kept muttering sheer unrighteousness. (Isaiah 59:3)
- For this is what Yehowah of armies has said; Cut down wood and throw up against Jerusalem a siege rampart. She is the city with which an accounting must be held. She is nothing but oppression in the midst of her. (Jeremiah 6:6)
