Ezekiel 9:8" And it came about that, while they were striking and I was left remaining, I proceeded to fall upon my face and cry out and say; Alas, O Sovereign Lord Yehowah! Are you bringing to ruin all the remaining ones of Israel while you are pouring out your rage upon Jerusalem?

[8] - References:

- Yehowah has accomplished his rage. He has poured out his burning anger. And he sets a fire ablaze in Zion, which eats up her foundations. (Lamentations 4:11)
- The kings of the earth and all the inhabitants of the productive land had not believed that the adversary and the enemy would come into the gates of Jerusalem. (Lamentations 4:12)
- Because of the sins of her prophets, the errors of her priests, there were in the midst of her those pouring out the blood of righteous ones. (Lamentations 4:13)
- At this Moses and Aaron fell upon their faces before all the congregation of the assembly of the sons of Israel. (Numbers 14:5)
- You men, rise up from the midst of this assembly, that I may exterminate them in an instant. At this they fell upon their faces. (Numbers 16:45)
- And I proceeded to say; Alas, O Sovereign Lord Yehowah! Truly you have absolutely deceived this people and Jerusalem, saying, Peace itself will become yours, and the sword has reached clear to the soul. (Jeremiah 4:10)
- And it came about that as soon as I prophesied Pelatiah the son of Benaiah himself died, and I proceeded to fall upon my face and cry with a loud voice and say; Alas, O Sovereign Lord Yehowah! Is it an extermination that you are executing with the remaining ones of Israel? (Ezekiel 11:13)
- Then Abraham approached and began to say; Will you really sweep away the righteous with the wicked? (Genesis 18:23)
- And as for you, O son of man, sigh with shaking hips. Even with bitterness you should sigh before their eyes. (Ezekiel 21:6)

Cry out and howl, O son of man, for it itself has come to be against my people, it is against all the chieftains of Israel. The very ones hurled to the sword have come to be with my people. Therefore make a slap on the thigh. (Ezekiel 21:12)
