- And also for the innocent blood that he had shed, so that he **filled** Jerusalem with innocent blood, and Yehowah did not consent to grant forgiveness. (**2 Kings 24:4**)
- And he proceeded to say to me; Have you seen, O son of man, what the elderly ones of the **house of Israel** are doing in the darkness, each one in the inner rooms of his showpiece? For they are saying; Yehowah is not **seeing** us. Yehowah **has left** the **land**. (**Ezekiel 8:12**)
- They **have** returned to the **errors** of their forefathers, the first ones, who refused to obey my words, but who themselves **have** walked after other gods in order to serve them. The **house of Israel** and the **house of Judah** **have** broken my covenant that I concluded with their forefathers. (**Jeremiah 11:10**)
- For I well know that after my death **you** will without fail act ruinously, and **you** will certainly turn aside from the way about which I **have** commanded **you**, and calamity will be bound to befall **you** at the close of the days, because **you** will do what is bad in the eyes of Yehowah so as to offend him by the works of **YOUR** hands. (**Deuteronomy 31:29**)
- And it came about because the sons of **Israel** had sinned against Yehowah their God, who brought them up out of the **land** of Egypt from under the hand of Pharaoh the king of Egypt, and they began to fear other gods. (**2 Kings 17:7**)
- Even all the chiefs of the priests and the people themselves committed unfaithfulness on a large scale, according to all the detestable things of the nations, so that they defiled the **house** of

- Yehowah which he had sanctified in Jerusalem. (2 Chronicles 36:14)
- Woe to the sinful nation, the people heavy with **error**, an evildoing seed, ruinous sons! They **have left** Yehowah, they **have** treated the Holy One of **Israel** with disrespect, they **have** turned backwards. (Isaiah 1:4)
 - And there was also innocent blood that Manasseh shed in very **great** quantity, until he had **filled** Jerusalem from end to end, besides his sin with which he caused **Judah** to sin by doing what was bad in the eyes of Yehowah. (2 Kings 21:16)
 - Also, in your skirts there **have** been found the blood marks of the souls of the innocent poor ones. Not in the act of breaking in **have** I found them, but they are upon all these. (Jeremiah 2:34)
 - Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah **has said**; Woe to the **city** of deeds of **bloodshed**! I myself also shall make the pile **great**. (Ezekiel 24:9)
 - And **you** say; If we were in the days of our forefathers, we would not be sharers with them in the blood of the prophets. (Matthew 23:30)
 - The people of the **land** themselves **have** carried on a scheme of defrauding and **have** done a tearing away in robbery, and the afflicted one and the poor one they **have** maltreated, and the alien resident they **have** defrauded without justice. (Ezekiel 22:29)
 - And he proceeded to say to me; Have you seen, O son of man, what the elderly ones of the **house** of **Israel** are doing in the darkness, each one in the inner rooms of his showpiece? For they are saying, Yehowah is not **seeing** us. Yehowah **has left** the **land**. (Ezekiel 8:12)
 - He **has said** in his heart; God **has** forgotten. He **has** concealed his face. He will certainly never see it. (Psalms 10:11)
 - Woe to those who are going very deep in concealing counsel from Yehowah himself, and whose deeds **have** occurred in a dark place, while they say; Who is **seeing** us, and who is knowing of us? (Isaiah 29:15)

- **Look! They make a bubbling forth with their mouth, swords are on their lips, for who is listening? ([Psalms 59:7](#))**
- **For Jerusalem [has](#) stumbled, and [Judah](#) itself [has](#) fallen, because their tongue and their dealings are against Yehowah, in behaving rebelliously in the eyes of his glory. ([Isaiah 3:8](#))**
- **Their own feet keep running to sheer badness, and they are in a hurry to shed innocent blood. Their thoughts are hurtful thoughts, despoiling and breakdown are in their highways. ([Isaiah 59:7](#))**
- **Make the chain, for the [land](#) itself [has](#) become [full](#) of bloodstained judgment and the [city](#) itself [has](#) become [full](#) of violence. ([Ezekiel 7:23](#))**
- **And he went on to say to me; Have you seen this, O son of man? Is it such a light thing to the [house](#) of [Judah](#) to do the detestable things that they [have](#) done here, that they [have](#) to fill the [land](#) with violence and that they should offend me again, and here they are thrusting out the shoot to my nose? ([Ezekiel 8:17](#))**
- **Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah [has said](#); As regards [YOUR](#) slain ones whom [YOU](#) people [have](#) put in the midst of her, they are the flesh, and she is the widemouthed cooking pot, and there will be a bringing forth of [YOU](#) yourselves out of the midst of her. ([Ezekiel 11:7](#))**
- **And they will certainly comfort [YOU](#) people when [YOU](#) see their way and their dealings, and [YOU](#) will [have](#) to know that it was not without cause that I shall [have](#) done all that I must do against her, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. ([Ezekiel 14:23](#))**
