- Daniel 1:17... And as for these children, the four of them, to them the true God gave knowledge and insight in all writing and wisdom, and Daniel himself had understanding in all sorts of visions and dreams.

- Wiser than my enemies your commandment makes me, because to time indefinite it is mine. (Psalms 119:98)
- For Yehowah himself gives wisdom, out of his mouth there are knowledge and discernment. (Proverbs 2:6)
- For to the man that is good before him he has given wisdom and knowledge and rejoicing, but to the sinner he has given the occupation of gathering and bringing together merely to give to the one that is good before the true God. This too is vanity and a striving after wind. (Ecclesiastes 2:26)
- And one corrects him according to what is right. His own God instructs him. (Isaiah 28:26)
- And he went on to say; Hear my words, please. If there came to be a prophet of Yours for Yehowah, it would be in a vision I would make myself known to him. In a dream I would speak to him. (Numbers 12:6)
- And as regards every matter of wisdom and understanding that the king inquired about from them, he even got to find them ten times better than all the magic-practicing priests and the conjurers that were in all his royal realm. (Daniel 1:20)
- O Belteshazzar the chief of the magic-practicing priests, because I myself well know that the spirit of the holy gods is in you and that there is no secret at all that is troubling you, tell me the visions of my dream that I have beheld and its interpretation. (Daniel 4:9)

- There exists a capable man in your kingdom in whom there is the spirit of holy gods, and in the days of your father illumination and insight and wisdom like the wisdom of gods were found in him, and King Nebuchadnezzar your father himself set him up as chief of the magic-practicing priests, the conjurers, the Chaldeans and the astrologers, even your father, O king. (Daniel 5:11)
- He was the son of a widowed woman from the tribe of Naphtali, and his father was a Tyrian man, a worker in copper, and he was full of the wisdom and the understanding and the knowledge for doing every sort of work in copper. Accordingly he came to King Solomon and began to do all his work. (1 Kings 7:14)
- And all the kings of the earth were seeking the face of Solomon to hear his wisdom, which the true God had put in his heart. (2 Chronicles 9:23)
- Surely it is the spirit in mortal men and the breath of the Almighty that gives them understanding. (Job 32:8)
- So I entered in among the exiled people at Tel-abib, who were dwelling by the river Chebar, and I began to dwell where they were dwelling, and I kept dwelling there for seven days, stunned in the midst of them. (Ezekiel 3:15)
- Children in whom there was no defect at all, but good in appearance and having insight into all wisdom and being acquainted with knowledge, and having discernment of what is known, in whom also there was ability to stand in the palace of the king, and to teach them the writing and the tongue of the Chaldeans. (Daniel 1:4)
- To you, O God of my forefathers, I am giving praise and commendation, because wisdom and mightiness you have given to me. And now you have made known to me what we requested of you, for you have made known to us the very matter of the king. (Daniel 2:23)
- However, there exists a God in the heavens who is a Revealer of secrets, and he has made known to King Nebuchadnezzar what is to occur in the final part of the days. Your dream and the visions of your head upon your bed, this it is. (Daniel 2:28)
- The king was answering Daniel and saying; Truly the God of YOU men is a God of gods and a Lord of kings and a Revealer of secrets, because you were able to reveal this secret. (Daniel 2:47)
- Forasmuch as an extraordinary spirit and knowledge and insight to interpret dreams and the explanation of riddles and the untying of

knots had been found in him, in Daniel, whom the king himself named Belteshazzar. Now let Daniel himself be called, that he may show the very interpretation. (Daniel 5:12)

- I have also heard concerning you that the spirit of gods is in you, and illumination and insight and wisdom extraordinary have been found in you. (Daniel 5:14)
- Then it was that this Daniel was steadily distinguishing himself over the high officials and the satraps, forasmuch as an extraordinary spirit was in him, and the king was intending to elevate him over all the kingdom. (Daniel 6:3)
- Then it came about that, while I myself, Daniel, was seeing the vision and seeking an understanding, why, look! There was standing in front of me someone in appearance like an able-bodied man. (Daniel 8:15)
- In the third year of Cyrus the king of Persia there was a matter revealed to Daniel, whose name was called Belteshazzar, and the matter was true, and there was a great military service. And he understood the matter, and he had understanding in the thing seen. (Daniel 10:1)
