- The rod of your strength Yehowah will send out of Zion, saying; Go subduing in the midst of your enemies. (Psalms 110:2)
- And many peoples will certainly go and say; Come, you people, and let us go up to the mountain of Yehowah, to the house of the God of Jacob, and he will instruct us about his ways, and we will walk in his paths. For out of Zion Law will go forth, and the word of Yehowah out of Jerusalem. (Isaiah 2:3)
- And a certain ruler questioned him, saying; Good Teacher, by doing what shall I inherit everlasting life? (Luke 18:18)
- Jesus said to him; Why do you call me good? Nobody is good,
 except one, God. (Luke 18:19)
- Every good gift and every perfect present is from above, for it comes down from the Father of the celestial lights, and with him there is not a variation of the turning of the shadow. (James 1:17)
- Until the Ancient of Days came and judgment itself was given in favor of the holy ones of the Supreme One, and the definite time arrived that the holy ones took possession of the kingdom itself.

- For when he sees his children, the work of my hands, in the midst of him, they will sanctify my name, and they will certainly sanctify the Holy One of Jacob, and the God of Israel they will regard with awe. (Isaiah 29:23)

- Joyfully cry out, you heavens, for Yehowah has taken action! Shout in triumph, all you lowest parts of the earth! Become cheerful, you mountains, with joyful outcry, you forest and all you trees in it! For Yehowah has repurchased Jacob, and on Israel he shows his beauty. (Isaiah 44:23)

- Happy are the mild-tempered ones, since they will inherit the earth. (Matthew 5:5)
- Anyone conquering will inherit these things, and I shall be his God and he will be my son. (Revelation 21:7)
- In reply he said; Every plant that my heavenly Father did not plant will be uprooted. (Matthew 15:13)
- For we are a product of his work and were created in union with Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared in advance for us to walk in them. (Ephesians 2:10)
- The one trusting in his riches, he himself will fall, but just like foliage the righteous ones will flourish. (Proverbs 11:28)
- In that day what Yehowah makes sprout will come to be for decoration and for glory, and the fruitage of the land will be something to be proud of and something beautiful for those of Israel who have escaped. (Isaiah 4:2)

- And it must occur that the ones remaining in Zion and the ones left over in Jerusalem will be said to be holy to him, everyone written down for life in Jerusalem. (Isaiah 4:3)
- You have added to the nation, O Yehowah, you have added to the nation, you have glorified yourself. You have extended afar all the borders of the land. (Isaiah 26:15)
- In the wilderness I shall set the cedar tree, the acacia and the myrtle and the oil tree. In the desert plain I shall place the juniper tree, the ash and the cypress at the same time. (Isaiah 41:19)
- The people whom I have formed for myself, that they should recount the praise of me. (Isaiah 43:21)
- This is what Yehowah has said, the Holy One of Israel and the Former of him; Ask me even about the things that are coming concerning my sons, and concerning the activity of my hands you people should command me. (Isaiah 45:11)
- I have brought near my righteousness. It is not far away, and my own salvation will not be late. And I will give in Zion salvation, to Israel my beauty. (Isaiah 46:13)
- Wake up, wake up, put on your strength, O Zion! Put on your beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the holy city! For no more will there come again into you the uncircumcised and unclean one. (Isaiah 52:1)
- You will prove to be firmly established in righteousness itself. You will be far away from oppression, for you will fear none, and from anything terrifying, for it will not come near you. (Isaiah 54:14)
- To assign to those mourning over Zion, to give them a headdress instead of ashes, the oil of exultation instead of mourning, the mantle of praise instead of the downhearted spirit, and they must be called big trees of righteousness, the planting of Yehowah, for him to be beautified. (Isaiah 61:3)
- And I will bring forth out of Jacob an offspring and out of Judah the hereditary possessor of my mountains, and my chosen ones must take possession of it, and my own servants will reside there. (Isaiah 65:9)
- And upon You I will cause humankind to walk, even my people Israel, and they must take possession of You, and You must become a hereditary possession to them, and You will not bereave them again of any more children. (Ezekiel 36:12)

- And they will actually dwell upon the land that I gave to my servant, to Jacob, in which YOUR forefathers dwelt, and they will actually dwell upon it, they and their sons and their sons' sons to time indefinite, and David my servant will be their chieftain to time indefinite. (Ezekiel 37:25)
- As regards the remaining ones of Israel, they will do no unrighteousness, nor speak a lie, nor will there be found in their mouths a tricky tongue, for they themselves will feed and actually lie stretched out, and there will be no one making them tremble. (Zephaniah 3:13)
