Psalms 23:4" Even though I walk in the valley of deep shadow, I fear nothing bad, for you are with me, your rod and your staff are the things that comfort me.

- Before I go away, and I shall not come back, to the land of darkness and deep shadow. (Job 10:21)
- Have the gates of death been uncovered to you, or the gates of deep shadow can you see? (Job 38:17)
- For you have crushed us in the place of jackals, and you cover us over with deep shadow. (Psalms 44:19)
- The people sitting in darkness saw a great light, and as for those sitting in a region of deathly shadow, light rose upon them. (Matthew 4:16)
- To give light to those sitting in darkness and death's shadow, to direct our feet prosperously in the way of peace. (Luke 1:79)
- I shall not be afraid of ten thousands of people who have set themselves in array against me round about. (Psalms 3:6)
- Yehowah is my light and my salvation. Of whom shall I be in fear? Yehowah is the stronghold of my life. Of whom shall I be in dread? (Psalms 27:1)
- Do not be afraid, for I am with you. Do not gaze about, for I am your God. I will fortify you. I will really help you. I will really keep fast hold of you with my right hand of righteousness. (Isaiah 41:10)
