Isaiah 56:10. His watchmen are blind. None of them have taken note. All of them are speechless dogs, they are not able to bark, panting, lying down, loving to slumber.

[14] - References

- Make the heart of this people unreceptive, and make their very ears unresponsive, and paste their very eyes together, that they may not see with their eyes and with their ears they may not hear, and that their own heart may not understand and that they may not actually turn back and get healing for themselves. (Isaiah 6:10)
- For upon You men Yehowah has poured a spirit of deep sleep, and he closes Your eyes, the prophets, and he has covered even YOUR heads, the visionaries. (Isaiah 29:10)
- LET them be. Blind guides is what they are. If, then, a blind man guides a blind man, both will fall into a pit. (Matthew 15:14)
- And they try to heal the breakdown of my people lightly, saying; There is peace! There is peace! When there is no peace. (Jeremiah 6:14)
- The prophets of Israel that are prophesying to Jerusalem and that are visioning for her a vision of peace, when there is no peace, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 13:16)

- For you yourselves know quite well that Yehowah's day is coming exactly as a thief in the night. (1 Thessalonians 5:2)
